# CRANE HAUL PORT TO AZ



This past spring, Bragg Heavy Transport was contracted to haul a new 13,000 crane from Port Heuneme to Chandler, Arizona, a journey of around 500 miles. The customer was utilizing this new crane to build a new Intel facility in Chandler, but needed assistance bringing the crane from Port to Arizona. BHT was contracted and utilized nearly the entirety of their fleet including MES Trailers, 9 Axles, Flat Beds and Low Beds, to safely and efficiently bring all of the components of the crane to the final location. The job was expected to take two months and be completed in 175 loads. The team was able to complete the job two weeks ahead of schedule and consolidate 7 loads to save time. This expediency was not done at the expense of safety, though. At Bragg Companies, Safety is one of our four Core Values and that was at play in this haul, as it always is.



# PALO VERDE ARIZONA JOB



Bragg Companies' Phoenix team recently took part in an exciting job at the APS Palo Verde facility. Built in the 1970's, the facility had scheduled updating while the cooling towers were down for refueling.

Bragg Companies came in with a Liebherr LR 1160 crawler in luffer configuration, Liebherr LR1280 crawler with fixed jib as well as our Tadano GR1600XL-2 for logistics, material movement and standby. The team worked 7 days a week, 24 hours a day to get the scheduled replacement parts in and return the towers to fully operational status within 18 days. In addition, the team replaced cooling tower fans, shrouds, and motors with the onsite plant mechanics.

All this work was completed on time and safely due to our highly trained staff and standard of superior service.
