

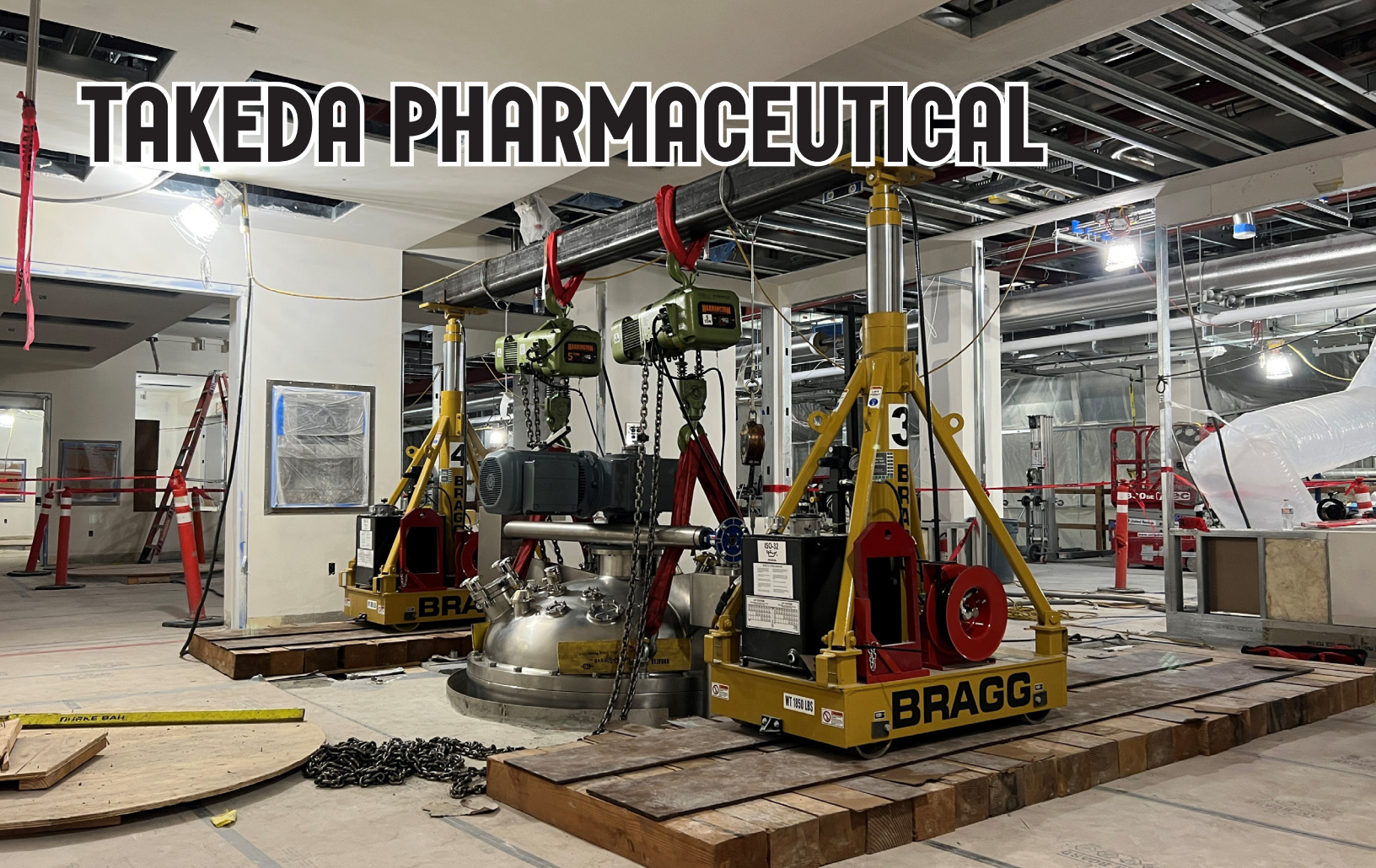

TAKEDA PHARMACEUTICAL

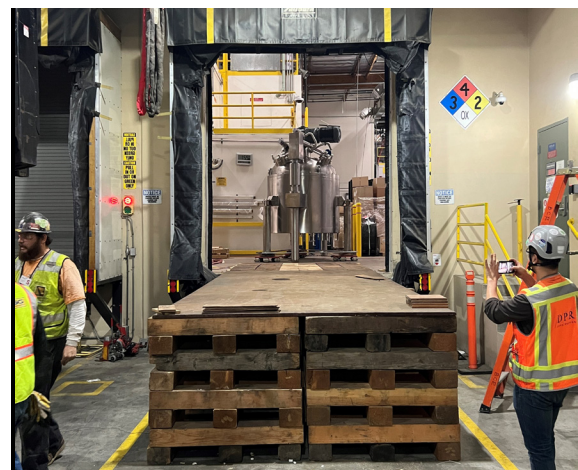


When Takeda Pharmaceutical in Los Angeles, CA needed their state-of-the-art production equipment installed into their facility, Bragg Companies was the right company for the job. Their newly modernized facility was two stories but had heavy duty equipment that still needed to be installed. Bragg Crane & Rigging's experience with complex and unique projects was perfect for this challenge.

The specialized equipment for the pharmaceutical processing line was brand new and shipped from manufacturers in Europe, so installing the equipment without any damage was key. There were 20 crates holding over 30 pieces of equipment, with the heaviest weighing in at 13,000 pounds.

To get the equipment in the building carefully and efficiently, Bragg's team made custom legs and spreader bars to introduce the equipment through the warehouse doors with just 1/8 of an inch of clearance through the doorframe using our 40/60 hoist truck and skates. Once on the skates, the equipment was moved through the building and rigged up through the floor with a custom rigging set up and 20/40 mini gantry to account for the minimal headroom when bringing it to the second floor.

Even with the strict parameters of this job and the detailed specifications that needed to be met, Bragg's team pulled it off without a hitch. The project was completed on schedule, on budget, and with zero incidents.

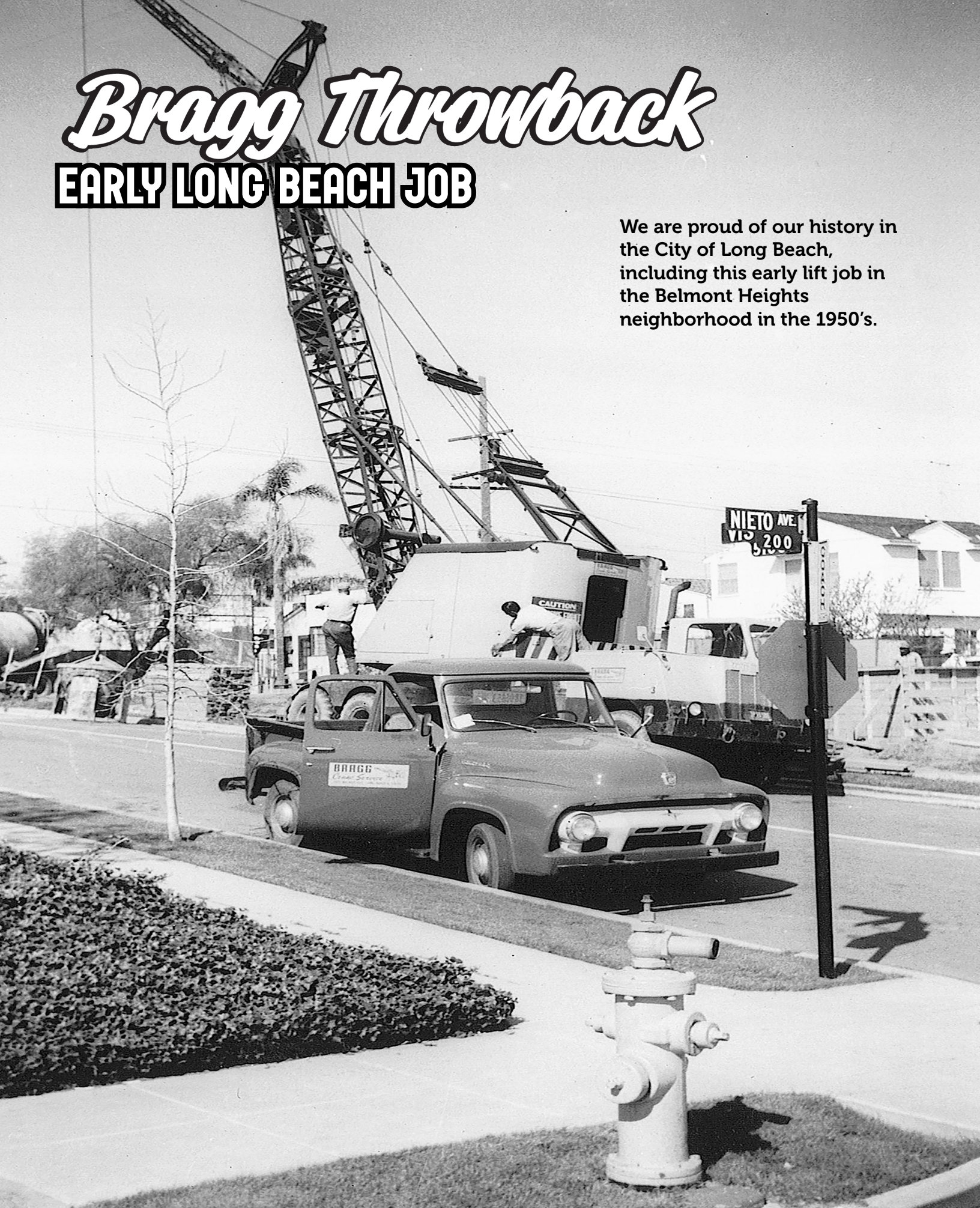
In addition, Bragg Companies recently received SC&RA's 2023 Crane & Rigging Group Safety Award. This award is given to member companies with a Workers' Compensation Modification Rate of 1.0 or less; Property Damage Frequency Rate of 1.0 or less; and an incident rate of 1.7 or less, which is less than the industry average of 3.4, as reported by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. Firms across the United States and around the world submit dozens of entries to the SC&RA Awards competition each year.

The awards program recognizes worldwide excellence in the crane, rigging and specialized transportation industry and Bragg is proud to receive this year's 2023 Crane & Rigging Group Safety Award.
